RELIGIOUS CALL FOR AUSTRALIA TO SUPPORT NUCLEAR WEAPONS BAN

CRA has signed an interfaith open letter to the prime minister and leader of the opposition, urging the government to support the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons. ICAN, which began in Melbourne and is now a global movement, is urging all nations, including Australia, to sign and ratify the agreement, which will enter into force after the 50th ratification. Anniversary of the Collapse of Factory in Bangladesh - 24 April 2013

The eight-storey Rana Plaza factory building near Dhaka collapsed in 2013, claiming 1,134 lives. This tragedy triggered international outrage and put pressure on clothing brands to improve pay and conditions at the factories that supply them. At the time, Pope Francis denounced as "slave labour" the conditions of the workers caught in this deadly collapse.

<u>Threads of Hope</u> is a reflection to help remember the workers at Rana Plaza, to become ever more aware of complicities of injustice in many global supply chains, and to give us courage to speak out and act (PDF).
