CATHOLIC RELIGIOUS HAVE ELECTED A NEW PRESIDENT AND COUNCIL MEMBERS

Peter Jones OSA, Provincial of the Augustinians of the Province of Australasia was elected as the new President of Catholic Religious Australia (CRA) at the 2022 National Assembly, held in Melbourne from 29 August to 1 September, along with a new Executive and new Council. THRESHOLDS OF TRANSFORMATION

Emmaus Productions Australia, in collaboration with Community Works USA, announces the forthcoming launch of *Thresholds of Transformation* - a multi-disciplined process, aimed at contributing to an evolving new world order of integral ecology as articulated in *Laudato Si'*. *Thresholds of Transformation* is currently being piloted by 18 groups of religious women in Australia, New Zealand, Africa and North America. Following the review of the Pilot Study, *Thresholds of Transformation* will be launched in February 2023.
