#### **CANONISATION DATE SET FOR SCALABRINIAN FOUNDER**

On 9 October 2022, Pope Francis will canonise Blessed <u>John Baptist Scalabrini</u> (1839-1905), "Father of Migrants". In 1887, he founded the *Congregation of the Missionaries of St Charles – Scalabrinians*. The <u>Scalabrinians in Australia</u> are also celebrating 70 years since their arrival on 2 November 1952.
