CRA CONTINUES TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE DISCUSSION

A number of CRA submissions were completed this past month—a contribution to the Continental Stage of the Bishops Synod; a report for a Congress of Religious Conferences to be held next week in Rome; a submission to the Federal Government on modern slavery; and two media releases on other justice issues.

THE WORK OF ANTI-SLAVERY NETWORKS

Research undertaken by Australian Catholic Religious Against Trafficking in Humans (ACRATH) and the University of Newcastle has highlighted the vulnerability of migrant workers in the Hunter region. Meanwhile, the efforts of Australian anti-slavery organisations are affirmed in this <u>statement</u> of Australian Catholic Anti-slavery Network (ACAN) and this <u>video message</u> from Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP.

YOUNG MERCY LINKS
