CRA WELCOMES GOVERNMENT PLEDGE TO ELIMINATE \$3 BILLION OF STUDENT DEBT

The Albanese government has <u>announced</u> that it would cap the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP) indexation rate, eliminating about \$3 billion of student debt. CRA welcomes this, having <u>written to the Prime Minister</u> in 2023 outlining concerns that Australian university graduates were facing lifelong debt.
