CHANGE TO WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA FROM 1 JULY 2020

From 1 July 2020, a National Police Certificate cannot be used by people working or volunteering with children in South Australia. Instead, people must have a valid Working with Children Check. Please be vigilant and use caution in your response, especially during these difficult times.
