CRA ENDORSES OPEN LETTER – TREATY ON THE PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS

CRA has signed the interfaith open letter in support of the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons, joining 46 other organisations. It will be made public on 6 August.

<u>ICAN Australia</u> is co-hosting an interfaith service for nuclear disarmament with the Australian Uniting Church, including prayers from the Hindu Council of Australia, the Australian Bahá'í Community, the Catholic Archdiocese of Sydney, the Buddhist Council of NSW and the Executive Council of Australian Jewry. They will commemorate the 75th anniversary of the nuclear attacks on Hiroshima and Nagasaki.
