NATIONAL WEEK OF SOLIDARITY, 6-12 SEPTEMBER

There are more than 16,000 children and young people seeking asylum in Australia, and their families are ineligible for JobKeeper, JobSeeker and Medicare.

<u>The Refugee Council of Australia</u> is launching a campaign called, National Week of Solidarity to support the expansion of a basic safety net for the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent economic downturn, so people are not left destitute and homeless. The campaign consists of a week of events, online and in-person, in schools, education centres and community groups across the country.

CRA SIGNS INTERFAITH LETTER IN SUPPORT OF THE PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS

The 75th anniversary of the Hiroshima bombing was commemorated on 6 August and the <u>hibakusha</u> honoured, with an <u>interfaith open letter</u> sent to the Prime Minister and the leader of the Opposition, and emailed to all federal parliamentarians. CRA is one of the 58 faith-based organisations which signed the letter, which is a contribution towards the stigmatisation and elimination of nuclear weapons.
