FRIENDSHIP AND SOLIDARITY – KEY THEMES IN POPE FRANCIS' ENCYCLICAL

Pope Francis has released the third encyclical letter of his pontificate: <u>Fratelli Tutti</u> (Brothers and Sisters All). The document focuses on the ideas of friendship and human solidarity and is seen as particularly relevant during the time of COVID-19. Read the <u>ACBC media release</u>.

LOW NUMBER OF PEOPLE APPLYING FOR NATIONAL REDRESS SCHEME IS A RED FLAG

A victim of historical child sexual abuse has won a landmark case in Victoria against the Catholic Church, giving him a second chance to sue for compensation.
