EL SALVADOR SETS BEATIFICATION DATE FOR RELIGIOUS AND LAY MARTYRS

The Salvadoran Bishops have announced the date of 22 January 2022 for the beatifications of Rutilio Grande SJ, Cosme Spessotto OFM, and two laymen, Manuel Solórzano, a senior sacristan, and Nelson Rutilio Lemus, a boy in his teens.
