AFGHAN REFUGEE ASSISTANCE

Advocacy efforts are taking place around Australia in response to the crisis unfolding in Afghanistan. CRA has been approached by a number of organisations for assistance with their work. Information about each of these initiatives can be found here.

CRA VOICES CALL FOR G20 ACTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

Catholic Agency for Overseas Development (CAFOD) has worked with various Catholic organisations to write a letter to all G20 governments in the run-up to COP26 on climate change, asking them to consign fossil fuels to history. A number of CRA Members have added their signatures to the letter which can be read here. CRA's President and National Executive Director have also written to Prime Minister Scott Morrison urging action in greater global solidarity to avert the worsening climate crisis. Read it here.

FOR A SYNODAL CHURCH

On 10 October 2021, Pope Francis opened a two-year process of consultation with the Faithful, leading to the 2023 Synod of Bishops: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission." In response to CICLSAL's request for religious involvement, CRA has devised a simple, flexible process for inviting Religious in Australia to participate in the synodal journey. The synodal journey will be launched in dioceses around the world on Sunday 17 October 2021. The Australian Catholic Bishops are inviting the People of God to make submissions via an online portal that will open on October 17 for the initial period of consultation, accessible at this <u>ACBC webpage</u>.

As the first general assembly of the Fifth Plenary Council of Australia closed over the weekend, the members approved a concluding statement sharing the fruits of the First Assembly and looking forward to nine months of 'prayer, reflection, maturation and development' leading up to the Second Assembly.
