CRA has devised <u>a simple, flexible process</u> for Religious in Australia to participate in the synodal journey towards the 2023 Synod of Bishops. The process is invitational. Given the short timeframe (responses due 29 November), please tailor the task to what is manageable, and if you require extra time let us know. Also, Religious in Brisbane Archdiocese have received a personal invitation from Archbishop Mark Coleridge to come together with him in reflection, as part of the synodal journey, referring to CRA's process.


