AMENDMENTS TO MODERN SLAVERY ACT PASSES IN NSW

The <u>NSW Modern Slavery Amendment Act</u> was passed in NSW Parliament last week. You may recall that ACRATH and CRA prepared a joint submission for the Inquiry. The NSW Modern Slavery Act was passed in June 2018. The amended Act will be implemented from 1 January 2022.

NSW VAD LAW UPDATE

Following the passing of the NSW Voluntary Assisted Dying (VAD) bill through the Lower House last week, NSW Right to Life has issued this <u>press release</u>. Meanwhile, HOPE asks why certain <u>amendments</u> to the bill were rejected by MPs, and <u>Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP</u> speaks at last week's prolife rally in Sydney.

PARLIAMENTARY PLEDGE

International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons (ICAN) draws our attention to the Parliamentary Pledge – a commitment by parliamentarians around the world to work for their government to join the UN-sponsored <u>Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons</u>.
