CRA'S NEW STRATEGIC PRIORITIES AND NEW COUNCIL

During the first meeting of the year, CRA's National Council elected a new Vice President, Mary-Clare Holland OP, to join the re-elected President, Peter Carroll FMS and re-confirmed Executive Member, Tom McDonough CP to form the new Executive of CRA. CRA ADDS ITS VOICE TO CALL FOR FREE AND ACCESSIBLE RATS

A <u>joint statement</u>, to which CRA is a signatory, calls for free and accessible Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) to ensure everyone in our community can be safe from this virus, not just those who can afford it. This is part of a broader petition to parliament by ACTU, to advocate for free RATs for all Australians.
