#### ONLINE PROCESSES - A REMINDER TO BE VIGILANT

CRA has learned that a major Catholic agency recently had their computer systems hacked, creating havoc at an online conference. The incident is being investigated by police and we will pass on any helpful information that might become available. In the meantime, a reminder to be vigilant and to review your systems for online events. Try to identify registrants where possible. It is recommended that conference links NOT be placed on public websites and social media, but sent to each registrant who makes a booking. This is not a fail-safe step but may provide some protection.
