Public Lecture by Rev Professor John F. Baldovin SJ

A Liturgical Reform in Peril? Sacrosanctum Concilium Sixty Years On

The modern liturgical movement reached a highpoint with the promulgation of Vatican II's Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (1963). But promulgation is one thing, reception another. How has the Constitution been received? Is the vision of the reform in peril? What remains to be done? How have the recent statements of Pope Francis moved the reform of the liturgy forward? What are the prospects for the future?



John F. Baldovin SJ is Professor of Historical and Liturgical Theology at the Boston College School of Theology and Ministry. He received his BA

from the College of the Holy Cross, an MDiv from Weston School of Theology, and MA, MPhil, and PhD from Yale University. Fr. Baldovin has taught at Fordham University, the Jesuit School of Theology at Berkeley, Weston Jesuit School of Theology in Cambridge, MA (1999–2008). He served on the advisory committee for the Bishops' Committee on the Liturgy of the USCCB (1989–1993) and on the advisory committee of the International Commission on English in the Liturgy (ICEL) (1994–2002). He is past president of the North American Academy of Liturgy (which presented him its Berakah Award in 2007), Societas Liturgica. and the International Jungmann Society for Jesuits and the Liturgy (2019–2022).

Widely published in journals including Worship, Theological Studies, America, and Commonweal, Fr. Baldovin's books include The Urban Character of Christian Worship: The Origins, Development and Meaning of Stational Liturgy (Pontifical Institute of Oriental Studies, 1987); Living Bread, Saving Cup: Understanding the Mass (Rowman and Littlefield, 2003), Reforming the Liturgy: A Response to the Critics (Liturgical, 2008) and Catholic Sacraments, edited with David Turnbloom (Paulist, 2015).
