This unit develops skills to teach meditation and prayer in a variety of contexts. Students will explore various approaches with a focus on silent meditation and establishing places of silence in a contemporary context.

Students will engage in practical experience in teaching meditation and prayer in a variety of contexts, such as, schools, hospitals, youth groups, parish groups, universities, aged-care facilities, retreat centres and homes.
